

NEIGHBORS HELPING NEIGHBORS

- At the Helping Hands Clinic, there were 2,311 visits of patients with no health insurance who fall within the 200% federal poverty guidelines.
- Central Services provided almost 100,000 services ranging from utility, mortgage, and rent assistance, food pantry, traveler's aid, prescription medication and Christmas toy program.
- Lakeway CASA improved the lives of 135 abused and neglected children by advocating on their behalf, so that they could have a safe, permanent and loving home.
- At MATS, 211 people received a temporary shelter, food, clothing and other basic needs in a home-like atmosphere, as they try to better their lives.
- Senior Citizens Home Assistance provided 13,946 hours of caregiving which included light housekeeping, cooking, laundry, grocery shopping and companionship.
- At Morristown-Hamblen Child Care Center, 198 children from low income families were given an opportunity for learning in a developmentally appropriate environment.
- There were 444 victims of domestic and sexual violence served by CEASE.

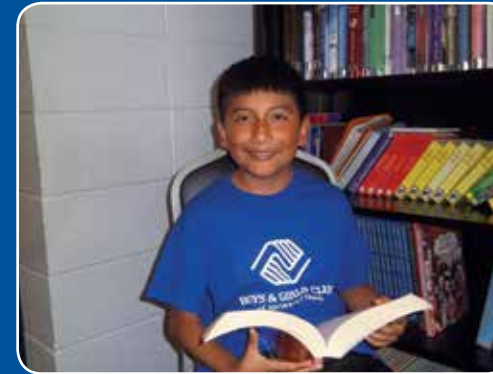
